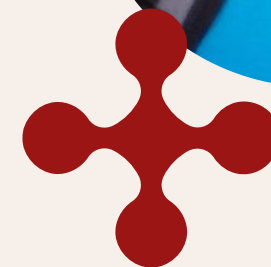
Here's a quick overview of what we offer
